



Akuma has launched its long awaited Tint on Demand Visor, with several feature/function upgrades. Key upgrades are highlighted below:

1. The visor can be operated manually using “on/off” buttons located inside and outside the visor.
2. The visor can be operated in automatic mode by holding the inside button for 3 seconds.
3. The owner can manually adjust the light level at which the visor “comes on/goes off” in automatic mode by holding the inside button for 6 seconds.
4. This version of the visor gets even darker. In Countries using the ECE 22.05 helmet safety standard, this visor is “FOR DAYTIME USE ONLY”.
5. The visor is now charged using a more universal USB port, located near the inside “on/off” button. A home computer or laptop with a USB port can now charge the visor.
6. Battery life has been increased to 25-30 hours per charge.
7. This visor is now being sold in versions that fit the Akuma V1, V2 and R Series Helmets.
8. Plans are underway to make available a “manually applied visor insert” that can be used to outfit other less technologically advanced helmets owned by Akuma customers.
